Amateur Gun Dog (Retrieving) – No Earlier than 7am local time \$58.00

Open Gun Dog – To Follow \$58.00

Silo Course 2

Open Puppy – No Earlier than 7:30am local time \$40.00

Amateur Derby – To Follow \$45.00

Amateur Puppy –To Follow \$40.00

Open Derby – To Follow \$45.00

COURSES, BIRDS & OTHER INFORMATION:

Silo Course 1 - single course without bird field & may be run as an alternating course in and out without bird field.

Silo Course 2 is a single course without a bird field.

Quail used in all stakes.

Amateur Gun Dog is a retrieving stake with callback for retrieve.

A blank cartridge will **NOT** be fired in Open Puppy Shotguns with blank shells will NOT be permitted.

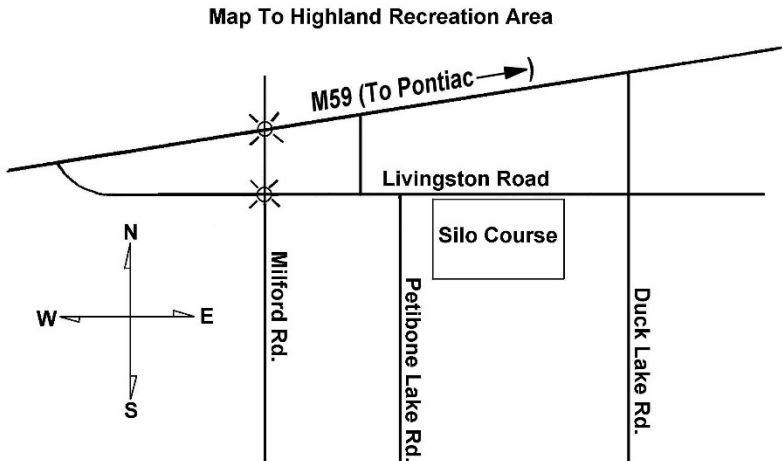
Horseback handling will NOT be permitted in any stake.

Tracking collars permitted per AKC rules and regulations, and are permitted in the callback for retrieve.

Orange vests are mandatory for judges, handlers, marshals, gunners and bird planters & spectators during callback for retrieve.

Standard AKC Rosettes to all placed dogs in each stake.

PARKING	<p>A Michigan Motor Vehicle State Park permit is required to park on the grounds. Cost is \$9.00 per day or \$32.00 for an annual permit for Michigan residents, and slightly higher for non-residents.</p>
CAMPING	<p>Camping is permitted on the Field Trial Grounds. A Camping fee of \$12 per night is to be paid to the trial secretary before leaving the event. A \$20 additional fee will be accessed by club if camping is not paid for prior to parties leaving grounds</p>
FOOD	<p>Coffee and donuts in the morning. Lunch will be available for a nominal fee</p>
